Government Minister Recommends Accredited Registers

On 3 November, speaking in the House of Commons, Parliamentary Under Secretary of State for Public Health, Jane Ellison MP, said: "Both the Government and the Professional Standards Authority (PSA) recommend that when a patient or service user chooses to visit a health or care practitioner who is unregulated, only those on an accredited register are consulted."

All CNHC registrants are on CNHC's Accredited Register and can use the CNHC quality mark. Our key message to the public is to **Choose with Confidence** with CNHC registrants and this government recommendation reinforces that message.
